
Greetings,

#### History of the ESDAA



There are currently five athletic associations for schools for the Deaf in the United States— Central, Eastern, Great Plains, Mason-Dixon and Western.

The Eastern Schools were the first to organize. In 1927, Fred A. Moore, a teacher at the New Jersey School for the Deaf, organized a basketball tournament with ten participating schools—Kendall, New York (Fanwood), Pennsylvania, American, New Jersey, St. Joseph's, Lexington, Western Pennsylvania, Virginia and Maryland. NJSD was the first tournament champion.

Six tournaments followed but they were not organized by a governing body. George (Billy) Harlow, Athletic Director at the Pennsylvania School for the Deaf, suggested that an organization be started to sponsor these tournaments. The Eastern School for the Deaf Athletic Association (ESDAA) was born! The first official tournament was held in 1934 at St. Joseph's School for the Deaf.

In 1961, the ESDAA Boy's Basketball tournament was split into two divisions and in 1994, it was restructured again—into three divisions. The divisions are based on school enrollment.

Charles M. Jochem of MKSD invited cheerleaders in 1966. They competed informally until 1980 when at a tournament at St. Mary's in Buffalo, the cheerleading tournament really began to take shape.

Paul Barr at the Maryland School for the Deaf started the girls basketball tournament in 1977. There are currently two divisions for girls basketball.

The ESDAA also supports tournaments in volleyball, soccer and wrestling. In the spring, the ESDAA track and field championships are held and unlike any of the other tournaments, all schools compete together.

All ESDAA events strive to provide opportunities for our students athletes to develop skills not just in athletics but in leadership and sportsmanship as well.
